NVCT Supporting Young People Leaving Care

NVCT has a 75% success rate engaging with and continuing to support young people who have no support from their parents and have failed to engage with other agencies.

Here are some examples of current cases concerning young people whom other agencies had failed to help

PK 20 yrs old, was homeless in Peterborough. He was supported to move into long term accommodation, he was given a mobile phone to enable him to be in contact with supporting agencies. He now has a full time job in a local pub where his work is praised and valued.

CB 17yrs old is living in a shared house in Northampton. She has Issues re. Accommodation and stability. Referred Nov.13th. Interested in childcare and hairdressing. She is now registered with apprenticeship team at Northampton College and has been put forward for a number of childcare apprenticeships, she has also been supported to start a placement at a nursery.

SS 16 yrs old from Peterborough, has had no formal education since 8, has very low self esteem. She finds engagement in projects very difficult. She has been helped to be a volunteer at a local play centre which has been very successful. She completed the Travel and Tourism induction week at Peterborough Regional College, she did not feel able to enrol on the course but staff continue to support and encourage her and have arranged for her to attend Domestic Abuse sessions to help her to work through her issues .

Fund Raising
